The other day I began watching “The Andy Griffith Show”. According to [Wikipedia](#),¹ Andy Griffith began college by studying to be a Moravian preacher, but he changed his major to music. After graduation, he taught music and drama for a few years in a High School. Andy’s early acting career was as a monologist. He then starred in a one-hour teleplay version of “[No Time for Sergeants](#)”. He later played in the theatrical version of the same name on Broadway. Then he played in its [film version](#). This is where he first met his famous partner, Deputy [Barney Fife](#) Don Knotts.

In 1960, “The Danny Thomas Show” had an episode “[Danny Meets Andy Griffith](#)” where Andy, was a County Sheriff who arrested Danny. Andy enjoyed the role so much that he spoke with Danny’s writers. “[The Andy Griffith Show](#)” made its debut just six months later. The show ran eight full seasons with 249 episodes. It was always in the top10 during all eight years seasons. He later acted in [Matlock](#) for nine years and other shows and movies. In 1996, he was interviewed on [The Today Show](#). Andy received the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2005.

In “The Danny Thomas Show” episode, Andy had a wife. But in the [first episode](#) of “The Andy Griffith Show”, Andy only had a young son named Opie ([Ron Howard](#)) and a housekeeper who was moving away named Rose. In this episode, Andy told Opie that he (Andy) was raised by his Aunt Bee ([Frances Bavier](#)) when he was Opie’s age. She is now returning to help raise Opie. (There was never any mention of Andy’s wife or Opie’s mother in the next eight years.) Andy did get married to Opie’s teacher in a spin-off show [Mayberry R.F.D.](#) in which they later moved from Mayberry.

The other night, I watched Season 1 Episode 8. It featured a man named Thomas Silby. He came to Andy. Andy looked at him as if he seen a ghost. Andy said that the last time he saw Tom was at Tom’s funeral. Tom’s wife had reported that while he has on a trip, he been run over by a train. They had a service and put up a gravestone for him. 


Tom & his tombstone.
