Our President

He died from complications of what was at the time believed to be pneumonia. Only three U.S. presidents have been formally impeached by Congress Andrew Johnson, Bill Clinton and Donald Trump. So far, no U.S. President has ever been removed from office through impeachment.

The most effective thing that you can do for your leaders is get on your hands and knees and pray. Then we get up and do what John F. Kennedy said in his inaugural address “Ask not what your country can do for you – ask what you can do for your country.”
