We are afraid that we might offend someone, or they will think badly of us. We act like we are in a county that it is illegal to speak about Christianity. To help overcome your fear is to memorize verses on salvation. Practice sharing to a fellow believer. Go out with someone on church visitation. (It was on church visitation that I met my wife of 43 years.) Most important pray for a concern and loving attitude, courage, the right opportunity, and the words to say. God does not speak to man in an audible voice. That is why He needs yours.
