Seven Gates of Hell

I live near a place known as Seven Gates of Hell located in [“Hell”am Township, PA](#) on Trout Run Road, AKA: Toad Road. From Mt. Zion Road take a right on Druck Valley Road and keep left at the fork near Glades Auction. Go past a barn on the right and a few expensive homes. The road will become narrow and unpaved as the trees become thick and dark. Sitting off the road on the left there is a metal gate with warning signs. A few months ago, I was there, touched the first gate and ran away scared.

A popular myth of this location states, that there was a mental institution erected to isolate people deemed insane from the rest of the world. One day in the 1800’s, a fire broke out. Firefighters could not reach the hospital in time. Over 100 patients died in the flames. Others escaped into the woods and feared to live on to stalk and murder. The gates were put up to trap the remaining inmates and when caught, they were beaten and killed. Today, there is nothing but thick trees with just one gate visible during the day. According to legend, the other six can only be seen at night. No one has ever returned from the fifth gate and the seventh gate is the direct entrance to Hell. Source [Wikipedia.org](#).
