

THOU SHALL NOT COVERT.

MC wraps 10 to 14 gag prizes.

MC cuts the references into individual verses and hands them out randomly according to below:

10 people = 6 verses per do not use 5< verses, 12 people = 5 per do not use 5< verses

11 people = 5 per do not use 5 ^ and 5< , 13 people = 5 use 5< but do not use 5 ^ , 14 people = 5 per use all verses

If not all verses are handed out they should be cross off the MC list.

The gag prizes go into an unclaim plie.

MC randomly calls out a verse reference from the MC list and crosses it out went called.

MC can ask for or read what the verse words are.

The player with the called verse takes one gift from unclaim or another person and discards that verse.

The prize they take is not unwrapped yet.

Each time a player takes a prize from someone, everyone shouts "Thou Shall Not Covert."

When a player has a second verse called, they take another gift from unclaim or another person and discards that verse.

A player can accumulate more than one wrapped gift.

When a person runs out of verses, they must keep one of the prizes they already have, their other prizes go to unclaim.

When the person runs out of verses, they can open and keep their single gift.

If a person does not have a gift on their last verse, they covert and keep one wrapped gift from someone or unclaim.

At the end everyone should have at least one prize and knowledge in Bible verses.
